Where site conditions are different than those described in the manufacturer's installation instructions, the installation must be designed by a registered professional engineer or architect to meet the same goals as those in the manufacturer's installation. • Manufactures Installation Manual or Alternate Standards shall be available at all times on site. • This PERMIT shall be displayed in a window so it is visible from the exterior until insignia is attached. • This permit is valid for 30 days from date issued and may be extended for additional 30 days upon written approval from the inspector.
